Purpose

The family of **Al DelMonte** is offering an educational scholarship to recognize *student athletes who demonstrate motivation, coachability, hustle and academics.*

Eligibility

- a senior at Glenbard East High School
- student athlete for 4 years
- GPA of 3.0 or better
- continuing education at a 2- or 4-year institution, vocational or trade school
- essay of 300 words or less (see attached)
- recommendation from coach (see attached)

Scholarship Information

One scholarship will be awarded in the amount of \$1,000. The awarded money is to be used toward the first year of continuing education. The applicants may attend 4-year colleges, 2-year colleges, vocational or trade schools. Payments will be made directly to the institution. The recipient will be announced at **the ESPY Awards Night on May 17, 2021, DEADLINE: Thursday, April 9, 2021.**

Al Del Monte was a parent, a grandfather, an athlete, a spectator, a coach, and a mentor to many youths during his life. He wrote a guide-book for his players years ago that focused on the importance of practice, consistency, and enthusiasm.
